## PSA 927ACB Red or White, 12 or 24vdc

### INSTRUCTIONS

This 927 series **LED** based unit is self-contained and requires no external power supply for installation. It is made with a polycarbonate lens that is UV protected and shatter resistant for durability. It is lighter, brighter, cooler, longer life and draws less than 1 amp (.2 amps). Weighs less than 2oz., stands 1.6" high (after mounting) and fits the same foot print as a standard Tail Light (with 1.8" CC Mounting). Available in 12V & 24V meets standard and nationally recognized specifications. **NON-PMA.**

### Technical Specification

Mounting is via two Mounting studs 632 x 7/8" through two owner provided mounting holes 9/64" diameter and using 632 rivnuts, nut plates or 632 KEP nuts if access to the studs is available. Also, one owner provided hole (11/16" diameter) for the socket.

### Operation and Installation

Installation is allowed under CAR 3 Regulations where applicable with the owner/operator maintenance and repair rules.

### Continued Airworthiness

The 927ACB series is designed with 45 LEDS. **Replace the lamp when 3 or more LEDS have failed.**

### Installation

**Test unit to a battery source or power supply to make sure unit is working before installing.**

Black wires to ground, Red wires to positive 12v or 24v system power. In order for the unit to operate properly, you must provide both a positive & negative battery source.

\*Check all airborne systems for EMC, EMI Interference.

\*Flight check by a certified pilot before flight is recommended.

**\*\*\*MAKE SURE LIGHT UNIT IS NOT ON PRIOR TO AIRCRAFT START UP!\*\*\***
